How much does Journey Ireland cost?

The early bird price for Journey Ireland is \$100 (non-refundable). It goes up on September 28 to \$150. While the cost is much higher (between 6-8x the price), IV Study Abroad works hard to raise student scholarships to give you this once in a lifetime experience.

What is included in Journey Ireland?

This 3-day, 3-night guided experience includes:

- Housing from Thursday night, October 30th, through Sunday afternoon, November 2nd.
- All meals are included.
- Transportation is included .

What is on the itinerary?

We will be walking in the footsteps of St. Patrick, St. Kevin, and St. Brigid during our weekend pilgrimage in Ireland. On Thursday night, we will head down to the ancient monastic city in Glendalough, Ireland. On Friday, we will explore the Way of St. Kevin. On Saturday, we will visit Kildare, the site of St. Brigid's Abbey. On Sunday, we will return to Dublin in the morning.

What is housing like?

We will share simple hostel rooms together in Glendalough. These are rooms with bunks and a private bathroom shared between 4 people.

What should I pack?

- Hiking shoes, preferably not tennis shoes (it often rains, so waterproof footwear is always a good idea)
- Wool or synthetic hiking socks, preferably not cotton athletic socks
- Waterproof jacket (always expect rain!)
- Personal toiletries
- A small journal if you like to write
- Pack light! We will be walking and traveling around a lot, so bring what you can carry on your back!

Which airport should I fly into?

Fly into the Dublin airport.

When should I arrive?

Plan to arrive at the Dublin airport no later than 2pm on October 30th. We plan to catch a bus to Glenddalough at 6pm that leaves from the center of Dublin. Please discuss with program leaders if you have any concerns about your ability to make the arrival time. We do understand that this likely means missing class on Thursday and Friday.

When should I depart?

Please book your flight to depart Dublin no earlier than 5pm on Sunday November 2nd if you can help it.

Can I stay in Ireland longer?

You are welcome to stay longer in Ireland, either before or after Journey! You will need to book your own accommodations for any additional nights.
