**STRATEGY 1**

**DEVELOP STUDENT LEADERS**



Our Forming Faithful Leaders (FFL) efforts are giving courageous student leaders the creative tools they need to help meet spiritual hunger on campus. At Purdue University, **Greek InterVarsity** leaders host weekly Bible studies in fraternity and sorority houses across campus. Today, a full **10 percent** of Purdue's Greek students have joined one of these studies.

InterVarsity **Discovery Kits**—offering step-by-step training and pre-assembled study materials in one package—help these leaders jumpstart and multiply more transformative small groups throughout the Greek system. Driven by student leadership, Purdue's Greek chapter grew to **over 580 members** this fall, the largest nationwide. Praise God!

## STRATEGY 2

### PLANT MORE WITNESSING COMMUNITIES

Every campus carries its own ministry opportunities and challenges. InterVarsity's **National Planting Coaching Center** exists to help ministers discern the best planting approaches for their unique campus context, as well as students and volunteers launching ministry at schools without an InterVarsity minister. As of last fall, our coaches have helped plant **20 new chapters**, 66% of the Center's total 30-plant goal.

Supportive strategies like these are bringing the fullness of the Gospel to the college campus in all its diversity. At **East Los Angeles Community College**, a Hispanic-Serving Institution planted in 2023 through our Regional Planting Leaders Cohort, the chapter has grown from seven members to **over 35** last spring. "Jesus is blowing the hinges off the doors of this ministry," InterVarsity minister Abner Ramos said of early ELAC outdoor Bible studies. "We're a physical presence in the quad area now, so people take notice and come by to see what we're doing."

## STRATEGY 3

### ACCELERATE MINISTRY

Leveraging lessons learned since kickoff, we launched a network of **Regional and Focused Ministries Recruiters** in Fall 2025 to help shepherd more staff candidates through the discernment and application process. Additionally, creative recruiting and networking efforts by our **Graduate & Faculty Ministries** have directly resulted in the hire of **four new staff** ministers, with several additional candidates currently in the process of applying.

Elsewhere, our **Theological Formation** efforts continue to help staff articulate a compelling Gospel witness to students of all backgrounds. After completing theological coursework supported by FFL, InterVarsity minister Chasen Robbins coached student leaders at the University of Utah to successfully co-host an annual InterFaith Dialogue with the Latter-Day Saint Student Association, inviting **230 attendees** to explore who Jesus is for themselves.
