How much does Journey Sonoma cost?

The cost for Journey Sonoma is \$1400 if you register before July 15th. After that, it's \$1500.

What is included in Journey Sonoma?

This 8-day, 8-night guided experience includes:

- Housing from Sunday night, October 12th through Monday morning October 20th.
- All breakfasts are included. Lunch and dinners are included, with the exception of one lunch on the first day walking. And trail snacks!
- Once the program begins Sunday afternoon, transportation is covered through the end of the program.

What is housing like?

On the first night, we will stay in a hotel in Petaluma near the starting point of the pilgrimage. For nights 2-4, we will be staying in host homes in Santa Rosa, CA. For the rest of the nights, we will be staying at Alliance Redwoods in Occidental, CA.

What will typical days be like?

During the Camino de Sonoma, we will start our mornings with an early breakfast, and then shuttle ourselves and the rental cars to the appropriate starting and ending locations that day. Most of the days, we will carry a sack lunch with us and be finished walking around 4:30pm at the latest. We stop along the way for important lessons and moments to learn from the Camino de Sonoma team. October 19th will be a debrief day.

What should I pack?

- Comfortable walking/hiking shoes (they suggest we bring more than one pair)
- Layers for autumn weather (check the forecast before you pack)
- Bring at least three hiking outfits and a lounge outfit. We can wash our clothes before we leave Santa Rosa.
- A sleeping bag
- Personal toiletries
- Bible and journal
- Pack light! While we aren't backpacking, we want to embrace the simplicity of pilgrimage. And we will have to pack up 3x on this trip.

How do I pay my balance after registering?

After registering, the balance may be paid by logging back into your registration via the confirmation email. On September 12th, 2025, the remaining balance will be automatically deducted from the credit or debit card with which you registered.

What if I need to cancel?

Cancellations will be handled on a case-by-case basis. The \$250 deposit will not be reimbursable and will go toward student sponsorships.

When and where should I arrive? Depart?

Plan to arrive at San Francisco Airport no later than 4pm on Sunday, October 12th. Please plan to depart no earlier than noon on Monday, October 20th. If you need to depart on the 19th, please talk to Bridget Gee.
