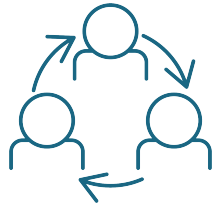

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Develop a team of CPLs so that there is always a backup leader



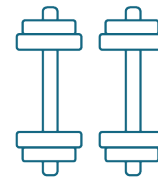

Conference & Training CC Inclusion Checklist



- Inclusion up front** ex: testimonies, worship team, CC staff & students have some up-front leadership
- Adjust start/end times & shorten travel distances** to help accomodate for work, family, church, and/or other responsibilities
- Prepare to significantly scholarship costs** (including costs of transportation)
- Be ready to build trust, dialogue, & partner with parents** in recruitment. Creating a resource for parents and/or being willing to talk with them may be important as many CC students are active household participants and will need parental support to attend
- Adjust content for CC students on relevant topics**
 - Nuance **how academics are discussed** - not just as an idol but also as an area of struggle & place to be faithful to
 - Speak on family and community with awareness that **students may be living at home and/or caring for family members**
 - Be inclusive of many realities when referring to the "college experience" to **acknowledge part-time students, commuters, & those working full-time**



Sample budget presented to a church

West Valley College Key Facts:

- **11,000 students** from Saratoga, CA and surrounding areas
- Very **little on-campus Christian ministry** (if any)
- Connected to Mission College (10,200 students) as **part of West Valley-Mission Community College Districts** (Mission also has little campus ministry)

Staff support, training, and expenses	\$25,000/yr
Student Leader Development (Conferences)	\$3,000/yr
On-Campus Evangelism	\$2,000/yr
<i>Already Raised</i>	\$12,000/yr
Remaining Need	\$14,000/yr

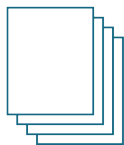

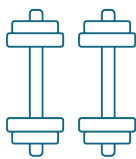
