- Help lead worship at campus gatherings
- Train and mentor a student worship leader or team
- Lead worship for a weekend conference (either individually or as part of a team)

Behind the Scenes

- Host students at your house
- Run A/V at fall conference
- Lend vehicle for travel to conferences, or drive students
- Sending newsletters (printing, folding, stuffing, stamping, mailing)
- Make copies, stuff binders, etc. for retreats
- Assist as meal coordinator for local retreats

Niche groups
