To advance the purpose of InterVarsity Christian Fellowship/USA, this position will: Hire and oversee assigned Link field staff, develop Christian community and ministry partnership with IFES leaders in assigned countries, develop relationships with InterVarsity regions and national movements to facilitate recruitment and ministry partnerships.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

Personal:

- Be a maturing disciple of Jesus Christ: growing in love for God, God's Word, God's people of every ethnicity and culture, and God's purposes in the world
- Be committed to and live consistently with InterVarsity's Frame of Reference and Code of Conduct
- Engage in spiritual leadership through teaching, preaching, discipling, leading Bible studies, and/or prayer and worship services in a local church or worshipping community

Duties and Essential Job Functions:

- Participate in Link's mobilization efforts focused on sending qualified staff to meet requests from IFES movements.
- Select, hire, and place new Link staff in collaboration with the Link Leadership Team (LLT)
- Develop and administer new staff orientation and training prior to sending staff to assigned field placements; collaborate with IFES supervisors, Link Training Coordinator, and others to provide quality training and professional development
- Ensure regular and effective pastoral care for assigned Link staff through regular communication, response to quarterly reports, on-site visits, collaboration with IFES field supervisors
- Conduct regular check-ins and performance assessments of assigned staff
- Ensure that Link staff or family can connect to resources for spiritual direction, prayer ministry, life coaching, counseling and/or crises intervention as needed
- Develop relationships and partner with IFES leaders, Global Programs staff, and Study Abroad Coordinator
- Work collaboratively with and participate in LLT team gatherings
- Represent InterVarsity Link within InterVarsity/USA, with the IFES, and in the broader Christian community
- Pray regularly for staff and partners
- Follow Link's "Team Covenant" to foster positive working relationships within the LLT
- Submit monthly Reflection Sheets to supervisor
- Secure personal financial and prayer support:
 - Raise 100% of salary and benefits
 - Communicate frequently with prayer partners and donors
 - Adhere to InterVarsity/USA and InterVarsity Link Fund Raising and Deficit Policy guidelines

Frame of Reference

All staff members subscribe annually to the Purpose Statement of InterVarsity:

In response to God's love, grace and truth: The purpose of InterVarsity Christian Fellowship/USA is to establish and advance at colleges and universities witnessing communities of students and faculty who follow Jesus as Savior and Lord: growing in love for God, God's Word, God's people of every ethnicity and culture and God's purposes in the world.

This purpose is admittedly more limited than the Great Commission. As a mission extension of the local church, we have adopted boundaries on our activities based on our call to serve a defined group of God's people. Within the context of InterVarsity's purpose, all of the relationships and tasks that staff members engage in as part of their work for InterVarsity have both eternal and temporal components.

Values:

InterVarsity is committed to developing men and women from diverse cultures, backgrounds, and generations, whom God calls to work with us for both shorter and longer periods of service, as we pursue the call of God in the university world.

Maturing Disciple of Jesus Christ:

Every InterVarsity staff member is to be a maturing disciple of the Lord Jesus Christ, growing in obedience to the Scriptures. The marks of a long-term love relationship with Christ in the fullness of His Spirit are described in Galatians 5:22: "The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self control." In the workplace, this fruit is revealed in healthy working relationships which encourage all staff to accomplish their work and enhance their focus on the spiritual aspects of their work.

Team Work:

Each individual staff person is a vital member of Christ's body. This means that we will work with one another in ways that honor and encourage all to grow in Christ while accomplishing His work. Our community requires that each individual serve as a team member in a collegial and open environment based on values, relationships, and vision as well as structure and position.
