Status: Full-Time / Exempt

Location: Cedar Campus - Cedarville, MI

To advance the purpose of InterVarsity and Cedar Campus, this position will assist in the building and maintenance functions of Cedar Campus, with a primary focus on building and construction. As an employee of Cedar Campus, this person is committed to the training, equipping and growth of all guests, staff and crew of Cedar Campus.

MAJOR RESPONSIBILIIES

Oversee the maintenance & repairs of camp buildings and grounds:

- Primary Responsibilities:
 - Building maintenance/repair and remodels
 - Woodshop and carpentry work
 - New construction as appropriate
 - Exterior and interior finishes
 - Furniture repair
 - Miscellaneous housing repairs
 - Oversee grounds and lawn maintenance
 - Firewood and firewood equipment
- Secondary Responsibilities:
 - Snow removal
 - o Plumbing repairs
 - Electrical repairs
 - Operate construction equipment
 - o Heavy trucking ability to obtain CDL if necessary
 - Welding

Contribute to the effectiveness of the team:

- Participate with the team in clean up and set up after guest groups
- Support all camp departments in meeting the needs and requirements of guests
- Prepare the wood-burning sauna when needed
- Identify and resolve simple maintenance items
- Serve as backup to other team members as required

Lead and serve the other staff at Cedar Campus:

- Supervise workgroups, crew, stewardship teams, volunteers as needed
- Provide pastoral care and support of supervisees and summer staff
- Provide leadership for a summer staff family group as needed
- · Participate in scheduled staff team activities and meetings
- Endorse and enforce appropriate safety policies and procedures
- Other miscellaneous duties as necessary to ensure a positive work/camp experience

Develop a funding base:

- Raise a percentage of annual salary amount to be determined prior to being hired
- Develop and communicate with potential donors in order to raise a designated amount
- Communicate with donors a least four times per year (Cedar Campus will assist with letters and mailings)
- · Comply with the Cedar Campus staff fund raising policy
