POSITION SUMMARY

To advance the purpose of InterVarsity Christian Fellowship/USA, this position will:

- Recruit, select, train, and provide member care for InterVarsity Link field staff Student Ministry Leaders, Ministry Team Leaders, and Senior Ministry Specialists,
- Develop a sense of Christian community and ministry partnership with leaders in Latin America,
- Develop relationships within InterVarsity Christian Fellowship/USA Regions and Areas to facilitate recruitment and ministry partnerships with IFES regions and national movements

MAJOR RESPONSIBILITIES

Spiritual Growth:

- Be a maturing disciple of Jesus Christ, growing in love for God, God's Word, God's people of every ethnicity and culture, and God's purposes in the world by:
 - Practicing daily spiritual disciplines
 - Pursuing spiritual relationships and involvement in a worshipping community
 - Continuing learning and growth in spiritual understanding, biblical knowledge, ministry experience and skills
- Engage in spiritual leadership through teaching, preaching, discipling, leading Bible studies, and/or
 prayer and worship services in a local church or worshipping community

Provide Quality Member Care for InterVarsity Link Field Staff

- Recruit New InterVarsity Link Staff:
 - o Speak about InterVarsity Link and IFES in various contexts
 - Develop strong, trusting relationships among InterVarsity staff directors and staff to promote recruitment of staff and students for Link and ministry partnerships with the IFES
 - o Participate with the Link Leadership Team (LLT) in the process of following up with recruits
 - Be aware of specific opportunities for Link staff to serve IFES Movements and regions.
- Select and Place New InterVarsity Link Staff
 - Develop relationships with applicants to help guide them in their journey towards service with InterVarsity Link
 - Work with the LLT to review applications, interview applicants, and call references
 - Work with IFES leadership to identify a placement for the applicant
- Orient and Train New InterVarsity Link Staff
 - Work with the Link Training Coordinator on the Link Orientation event

- Work with the Link Training Coordinator to provide other training and/or resources for the new Link staff (as needed)
- Encourage and coach (as needed) the new Link staff in their initial ministry partner development and additional training that may be required
- Supervise InterVarsity Link Field Staff
 - Ensure regular, effective pastoral care for Link field staff and coordinate on-site supervision and care with IFES supervisor
 - o Initiate regular communications with staff via phone, Skype, and email
 - Visit the supervisory region regularly for on-site pastoral visits and connecting with IFES leaders in the region
 - o Intervene in team conflicts or personal problems when requested
 - Collaborate with IFES Supervisors, the InterVarsity Link Training Coordinator, and other training or education programs to help provide quality training and professional development for InterVarsity Link staff
 - Help ensure that the Link Field Staff person or family can connect to resources for prayer ministry, life coaching, psychological counseling, and/or crisis intervention when needed.
- Provide administrative services and financial management that enables InterVarsity Link staff to flourish in their placements
 - Interface when needed with InterVarsity departments that serve Link staff such as the Missions Department, HR, Income, Accounting, Legal, etc.
 - Ensure adherence to Link and IFES policies, procedures, reporting requirements and financial guidelines, review and authorize budgets and expense reporting
 - Oversee staff ministry partner development plans and provide encouragment and coaching to help the staff remain in good financial standing

Partner with and serve IFES in Latin America:

- Build strong, trusting relationships with IFES Regional Secretary, the Regional Team, and General Secretaries of the IFES movements in Latin America
- Identify opportunities for InterVarsity Link staff to serve in the region
- Attend Regional and national conferences at the request of the Regional Secretary or General Secretaries
- Offer training and coaching not only to Link staff in the Region(s) but also to regional and national IFES Staff if requested
- Be available to the Regional Secretary to help intervene or moderate team conflicts or personal problems of the Link staff if requested.
- Be open to other ways of serving Latin America which the Regional Secretary(ies) may request.

Contribute to the Effectiveness and Team Life of the Link Leadership Team (LLT)

- Participate in all LLT team meetings, conferences, retreats, etc. as well as Ministry Staff Coordinator (LSC) meetings
- Work collaboratively with other LLT members in Link's recruiting, selecting, hiring, training, member care, and debriefing activities and programs.
- Abide by LLT policies and commitments
- Be willing to take on other responsibilities (i.e. helping with web development, recruiting, administration) as needed and as gifts and experiences dictate

Secure personal financial and prayer support:

- Raise 100% of salary and benefits
- Communicate frequently with prayer partners and donors
- Adhere to InterVarsity/USA and InterVarsity Link Fund Raising and Deficit Policy guidelines
- Represent InterVarsity Link within InterVarsity/USA, with the IFES, and in the broader Christian community
