Tips for You (The Inviter)

- Know why you are inviting your friends.
 - You love your friends
 - You long for them to encounter Jesus for themselves

- Know the barriers you face to making bold and winsome invitations.
 - Fear of rejection (people might say no!)
 - Fear of being awkward
 - Being busy, not prioritizing it or being intentional

- Be intentional: Plan when, where, how, and who you will invite.

Tips for Making Your Invitation:

- Avoid "Christiany" language that carries baggage or that your friends won't understand. "Bible study" could mean a variety of things to your friends, but it probably won't mean for them what it does for you.

Instead of "I'm having a Bible study" try "I'm hosting a discussion group talking about the life of Jesus."
- Give them all of the important details like time and location.

A flier with all of the info can be really helpful here too.
- Make sure to communicate personally and specifically why this will be good for them.

"I'm hosting a discussion group on the life of Jesus this Thursday night and you're one of the first people I thought about inviting. I know that you're a really spiritual person and I always appreciate your perspective on things. I'd love for you to come!"
